What is the Junior Warden Scheme?

The Junior Warden scheme is being made available for years 3 to 6 at Cross Gates Primary School. It is being delivered as an extra-curricular activity run at lunchtimes. The monthly sessions are scheduled to last a maximum of one hour.

The scheme aims to encourage good citizenship and promote community spirit among young people by spending time with some of the organisations and services working to improve their area.

During this time the Junior Wardens will take part in sessions on:

- Fire safety
- Accident and injuries
- Law and order
- Health eating - zest for life
- Health awareness - the dangers of drink, drugs and smoking

You will also help with reporting environmental issues including reporting graffiti and abandoned cars and taking part in litter picks.
